### I. Hypostatic Union of JESUS CHRIST



Uniqueness of JESUS CHRIST

CHRIST the GOD-man.

Son of GOD & Son of man.

(Romans 1:1-4)

JESUS CHRIST is <u>FULLY</u> God and <u>PERFECT</u> man at the same time.

#### A. Significance... Son of GOD

"For God so loved the world, that He gave <u>His only begotten Son</u>, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life."

John 3:16

#### Begotten – monogenes – one of a kind.

"Begotten" does not mean created.

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. All things came into being through Him... And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth... For the Law was given through Moses; grace and truth were realized through Jesus Christ. No one has seen God at any time; the only begotten God who is in the bosom of the Father He has explained Him."

John 1:1-18

(Genesis 1:1, Colossians 2:9, Titus 2:11-13, 2 Peter 1:1)

JESUS CHRIST is GOD.

#### A. Significance... Son of GOD

"We have believed and have come to know that You are the Holy One of God."

John 6:69

"The angel answered and said to her, 'The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; and for that reason the Holy Child shall be called the Son of God." Luke 1:35

"For this reason therefore the Jews were seeking all the more to kill Him, because He not only was breaking the Sabbath, but also was calling God His own Father, making Himself equal with God."

(Matthew 8:29, 14:33, 16:16, 26:63-64, John 17:1)

# JESUS CHRIST as the Son of GOD pertains to His <u>HOLINESS</u> as <u>GOD</u>.

#### B. Significance... Son of Man

"For even the <u>Son of Man</u> did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Mark 10:45

#### Man – anthropos – human being.

In His humanity, JESUS CHRIST...

<u>Hungered</u> – *Matthew 4:2* 

Thirsted - John 19:28

Became Tired - John 4:6

Was Tempted - Mark 1:13, James 1:13, Hebrews 4:15

<u>Bled</u> – *John 19:34* 

<u>Died</u> – Luke 23:46

(Hebrews 2:17-18)

"Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be <u>grasped</u>, but <u>emptied</u> Himself, taking the form of a <u>bond-servant</u>, and being made in the likeness of men. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross." *Philippians 2:5-8* 

Grasped – harpagmos – <u>asserted or utilized</u>.

Emptied – kenoo – <u>lay aside one's privileges</u>.

Bond-servant – doulus – willing servant.

# The <u>HUMANITY</u> of CHRIST had a beginning but He Himself is <u>ETERNAL</u>.

#### C. Significance... Son of GOD and Son of Man

"For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form."

Colossians 2:9

Deity - theotes - the state of being GOD.

Bodily form – *somatikos* – <u>corporal/material</u>.

(John 4:24, Romans 9:5, Matthew 1:23)

#### JESUS CHRIST is GOD in the FLESH.

"Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

John 1:29

"Worthy is the <u>Lamb that was slain</u> to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honour and glory and blessing."

\*Revelation 5:12

"Therefore it was necessary for the copies of the things in the heavens to be cleansed with these, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these."

Hebrews 9:22-28

#### C. Significance... <u>JESUS CHRIST the GOD-man</u>

Son of GOD <u>PERTAINS</u> to the holiness of His <u>DEITY</u>.

Son of Man <u>PERTAINED</u> to the humility of His <u>HUMANITY</u>.

JESUS CHRIST <u>ALONE</u>

<u>FULFILLED</u> the <u>HOLY SACRIFICE</u>

required by the Law for the forgiveness of sins.

(Hebrews 10:1-18 & John 14:6)

### II. Death of CHRIST



A. Significance... Substitution

"But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

Romans 5:8

for - huper/hoo-per - in behalf of.

"Just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom <u>for</u> many."

Matthew 20:28

for - anti/an-tee - in place of.

CHRIST did <u>NOT</u> suffer the <u>EXACT</u> punishment that <u>WE</u> deserve for <u>OUR</u> sins, which is eternity in <u>HELL</u>, but He did suffer the <u>SEVERITY</u> of punishment that <u>OUR</u> sins <u>DESERVE</u>.

(Acts 2:22-24 & Philippians 2:5-11)

#### A. Significance... Substitution



# JESUS' eternal <u>DIVINITY</u> and transcedent <u>HOLINESS</u> surpasses mankind's <u>TEMPORAL</u> humanity and <u>TOTAL</u> depravity.

"He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him."

2 Corinthians 5:21

In place of + In behalf of

The death of CHRIST was completely in *PLACE* of us and on our *BEHALF*.

#### B. Significance... Propitiation

"In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His <u>Son</u> to be the <u>propitiation</u> for our sins."

1 John 4:10

"and <u>He Himself</u> is the <u>propitiation</u> for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for those of the whole world."

1 John 2:2

#### Propitiation – hilasterion – <u>Satisfactory Sacrifice</u>.

#### Atonement – kaphar/kippur – <u>to cover</u>.

(Exodus 30:10, John 1:29)

"Whom God displayed publicly as a <u>propitiation</u> in <u>His</u> blood through faith. This was to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the <u>forbearance</u> of God He passed over the sins previously committed"

Romans 3:25

"For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins."

Hebrews 10:4

"...He appeared in order to take away sins; and in Him there is no sin."

1 John 3:5

"According to the <u>Law</u>, one may almost say, all things are cleansed with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.

### The death of CHRIST completely <u>SATISFIED</u> the <u>LAW</u> of GOD for our sake.

#### **B. Significance...** Propitiation

"He was led as a sheep to <u>slaughter</u>; and as a Lamb before its Shearer is silent, so He does not open His mouth."

Acts 8:32

"My God, My God, Why have You forsaken Me?"

Matthew 27:46

"As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see it and be satisfied"

Isaiah 53

"It is finished"

John 19:30

# The death of CHRIST completely <u>SATISFIED</u> the <u>WRATH</u> of GOD for our sake.

"Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the <u>wrath</u> of God through Him."

Romans 5:9

"It is a terrifying thing to fall into the hands of the living God."

Hebrews 10:29-31

"...but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

John 3:16-36

(1 Thessalonians 1:9-10, 5:9-10)

# In the crucifixion of CHRIST, the Scripture reveals the absolute <u>SUBMISSION</u>, <u>SEVERITY</u>, and <u>SUFFICIENCY</u> of His death on the cross for our sake.

(Matthew 26:38-39, Mark 15:33-34, Luke 23:46, Hebrews 5:7-9)

#### C. Significance... Reconciliation

"For <u>while</u> we were <u>enemies</u> we were <u>reconciled</u> to God <u>through</u> the death of His Son, much more, having been <u>reconciled</u>, we shall be saved <u>by</u> His life."

\*\*Romans 5:10

#### Reconciled – katallasso – <u>return to favour</u>.

"Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation, namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God."

2 Corinthians 5:18-20

Only because of the <u>DEATH</u> of CHRIST on the cross, which served as <u>SUBSTITUTION</u> and <u>PROPITIATION</u> for our sake, is <u>RECONCILIATION</u> with GOD possible only through faith in JESUS CHRIST <u>ALONE</u>.

People need to be reconciled TO GOD.

Only Christians are reconciled <u>TO GOD</u>.

All Christians have been given the MINISTRY of RECONCILIATION.

Romans 1:18-20

#### D. Significance... Redemption

"In Him we have <u>redemption</u> through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace" *Ephesians 1:7* 

#### Redemption – apolutrosis – A release effected by payment

"For the wages of sin is death..."

Romans 6:23

(Romans 8:1-2)

"When you were dead in your transgressions... He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions, having <u>canceled out the certificate of debt</u> consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross."

Colossians 2:13-14

(Galatians 4:4-5)

#### Payment was made by CHRIST for our <u>DEBT</u> to GOD.

"For to this end Christ died and lived again, that He might be <u>Lord</u> both of the dead and of the living."

Romans 14:9

(2 Peter 2:1, Philippians 2:8-11, John 5:22-23)

# Payment was made by CHRIST for His *LORDSHIP* over all creation.

"Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood."

#### Purchased – peripoieomai – payment for personal ownership

(1 Corinthians 6:19-20, Titus 2:13-14, Romans 8)

# Payment was made by CHRIST for His <u>OWNERSHIP</u> of the Church/Christians.

#### D. Significance... Redemption

Payment was made for our <u>DEBT</u>.

Payment was made for His <u>LORDSHIP</u>.

Payment was made for His <u>OWNERSHIP</u>.

### **Death of CHRIST**

Significance... <u>SUBSTITUTION</u>.

Significance... <u>PROPITIATION</u>.


Significance... <u>RECONCILIATION</u>.

### III. Resurrection of CHRIST



"And with great power the apostles were giving <u>testimony</u> to the <u>resurrection</u> of the Lord Jesus..."

\*\*Acts 4:33\*\*

Testimony – marturion – eyewitness.

Resurrection – anatasis – rising from the dead.

"While they were telling these things, He Himself stood in their midst...But they were startled and frightened and thought that they were seeing a spirit. And He said to them, 'Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? See My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself, touch Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have."

Luke 24:36-39

(Genesis 2:17, Ephesians 2:1-7, Hebrews 7:23-28, 1 Corinthians 15:12-22)

#### Scripture refers to a **BODILY RESURRECTION**.

The Bodily Resurrection of JESUS CHRIST testifies to His All-Sufficiency to save mankind from the <u>SPIRITUAL</u> and <u>PHYSICAL</u> judgement for our sins which is death or hell.

#### **Evidence** of the Resurrection...

#### **CRUCIFIXION** John 19:31-35

#### **EMPTY TOMB** Matthew 28:11-15

#### **EYE WITNESSES** 1 Corinthians 15:5-8

"and that He <u>appeared</u> to <u>Cephas</u>, then to the <u>twelve</u>. After that He appeared to more than <u>five hundred</u> <u>brethren</u> at one time, most of whom remain until now, but some have fallen asleep; then He appeared to <u>James</u>, then to <u>all the apostles</u>; and last of all, as to one untimely born, He appeared to <u>me</u> also."

#### **CHANGED LIVES**

**Before** – *Matthew 26:55-56* "Then all the disciples left Him and fled."

**Before** – *Matthew 26:69-75* "I do not know the man!"

**Before** – Acts 8:3 & 9:1-2 "Saul began ravaging the church"

**After** – *Acts 8:1* "all were scattered...except the apostles"

"they kept right on teaching and preaching

#### A. Significance... Justification

"He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification." Romans 4:25

#### Justification – dikaiosis – to declare righteous

"More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord... not having a righteousness of my own derived from the Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith, that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death; in order that I may attain to the resurrection from the dead."

Philippians 3:8-11

"Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now declaring to men that all people everywhere should repent, because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead."

Acts 17:30-31

"And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once and after this comes judgment, so Christ also, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time for salvation without reference to sin, to those who eagerly await Him."

### Death of CHRIST: Our sins <u>IMPUTED</u> or <u>COUNTED</u> on CHRIST.

Resurrection of CHRIST:
CHRIST'S righteousness <u>IMPUTED</u> or <u>COUNTED</u>
on Christians.

All who believe in JESUS CHRIST according to Scripture will be <u>DECLARED</u> righteous on the day of Judgement by JESUS CHRIST.

(Hebrews 2:17, 7:23-25, 9:23-25, 1 Timothy 2:5-6, 2 Corinthians 5:21)

#### B. Significance... Adoption

"But as many as received Him, to them <u>He gave the right to become children of God</u>, even to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of will of man, but of God."

John 1:12-13

#### Right – exousia – <u>Authority</u>, <u>Ability and Liberty</u>

"But when the fullness of time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law, so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoptions as sons. Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying Abba! Father! Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son, then an heir through God."

Galatians 4:4-7

"For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus."

#### Adoption through <u>FAITH</u> in JESUS CHRIST.

### Believers are given the <u>LIBERTY</u>, <u>AUTHORITY</u>, and <u>ABILITY</u> to become children of GOD, <u>ONLY</u> through faith in JESUS CHRIST.

(Ephesians 1:3-6, Romans 8)

#### C. Significance... Sanctified & Sanctification

"Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth... For their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they themselves also may be sanctified in truth."

John 17:17-19

(1 Corinthians 1:2 & 1 Corinthians 6:11)

#### Significance... Sanctified

"...I am sending you, to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me."

Acts 26:17-18

#### Sanctified – hagiazo – to set apart.

(Colossians 1:13-14, 1 John 5:19, John 12:31, Matthew 25:41)

#### Significance... Sanctification

"For this is the will of God, your <u>sanctification</u>; that is, that you abstain from sexual immorality... For God has not called us for the purpose of impurity, but in <u>sanctification</u>." 1 Thessalonians 4:1-8

#### Sanctification – hagiasmos – Purification.

(2 Thessalonians 2:13, 1 Peter 1:14-16, Hebrews 12:4-11, 1 John 1:9, Revelation 3:19)

#### C. Significance... <u>Sanctified</u> & <u>Sanctification</u>

#### Christians have been <u>SET APART</u> by GOD in JESUS CHRIST.

Christians are in the <u>PROCESS</u> of <u>PURIFICATION</u> by GOD from sin.

It can also be said that...

Christians are <u>SAVED</u> from the <u>PENALTY</u> of sin.

Christians are <u>BEING</u> saved from the <u>POWER</u> of sin.

Christians <u>WILL BE</u> saved from the <u>PRESENCE</u> of sin.

#### D. Significance... Future Glorification

"The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and <u>fellow heirs with Christ</u>, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be <u>glorified</u> <u>with Him</u>."

\*\*Romans 8:16-17

#### Glorified – sundoxazo – to approve together.

"He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne."

\*Revelation 3:20-21\*

And there will no longer be any night; and they will not need of the light of a lamp nor the light of the sun, because the Lord God will illumine them; and they will reign forever and ever." Revelation 22:1-5

# Christians, in the future, will <u>REIGN</u> forever with JESUS CHRIST.

"For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ; who will transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His glory..."

Philippians 3:20-21

# Christians, in the future, will be given a <u>RESURRECTED</u> or <u>GLORIFIED</u> body.

(Romans 8:20-23, 1 John 3:2, Acts 1:11)

"So also is the <u>resurrection</u> of the dead. It is sown a perishable body, it is <u>raised</u> an imperishable body; it is sown in dishonour, it is <u>raised</u> in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is <u>raised</u> in power; it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body."

1 Corinthians 15:42-44

Christians, in the future, will experience both <u>PHYSICAL</u> and <u>POSITIONAL</u> glorification and will experience the <u>SURPASSING</u> riches of GOD'S <u>GRACE</u> in JESUS CHRIST.

### IV. Mystery of the Trinity



The FATHER is GOD.

The <u>SON</u> is GOD.

The <u>HOLY SPIRIT</u> is GOD.

There is only **ONE** GOD.

There is <u>NOTHING</u> in creation that can fully <u>COMPREHEND</u> nor <u>EXPLAIN</u> our Triune GOD.

#### A. Significance... the <u>Father</u> is GOD

"To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ who are at Colossae; Grace to you and peace from God our Father. We give thanks to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you"

Colossians 1:2-3

Scripture explicitly states that the Father is GOD over 70 times.

#### B. Significance... the **Son** is GOD

"In the beginning was the Word... the Word was God... the Word became flesh... Jesus Christ."

John 1:1-18

(Titus 2:11-13, 2 Peter 1:1, Colossians 2:9)

#### The <u>BIBLE</u> declares the <u>DEITY</u> of JESUS CHRIST.

"I and the Father are one."

John 10:24-38

One - heis/hice - one essence.

"Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I Am."

John 8:53-59

(Exodus 3:14)

"Your sins are forgiven"

Mark 2:1-12

#### JESUS CHRIST declared His own DEITY.

"<u>God</u>, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets...in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world... <u>For to which of the angels did He ever say</u>, 'You are My Son, today I have begotten You... and <u>let all the angels of God worship Him'</u>... <u>But of the Son He says</u>, 'Your throne, O God, is forever and ever... You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; <u>Therefore God</u>, Your God, has anointed You...'" <u>Hebrews 1:1-9</u>

# GOD the <u>FATHER</u> declared the <u>DEITY</u> of JESUS CHRIST.

#### C. Significance... the Holy Spirit is GOD

"But a man named Ananias, with his wife Saphira, sold a piece of property, and kept back some of the price for himself, with his wife's full knowledge, and bringing a portion of it, he laid it at the apostles' feet. 

#### SALVATION THROUGH THE TRINITY: Significance... GOD the Father

"Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and <u>believes Him who sent Me</u>, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life."

### The <u>SON</u> teaches that people must believe in the <u>FATHER</u>.

"For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day."

John 6:40

### The will of the <u>FATHER</u> is for people to believe in <u>JESUS CHRIST</u>.

"For God so loved the world...For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him."

John 3:16-18

"No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This commandment I received from My Father."

John 10:18

The <u>FATHER</u> sent His <u>SON</u> because of His <u>LOVE</u> for us.

#### SALVATION THROUGH THE TRINITY: Significance... GOD the Son

#### SALVATION THROUGH THE TRINITY: Significance... GOD the Holy Spirit

Grieve – *lupeo*/loo-peh-o – <u>to cause deep sorrow</u>.

Sealed – sphragizo/sfrag-id-zo – to authenticate.

"Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If any man destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, and that is what you are."

1 Corinthians 3:16-17 (Romans 5:5)

#### Work of Salvation of our <u>Triune GOD</u>

"This is the <u>One</u> who came by water and blood, <u>Jesus Christ</u>; not with water only, but with the water and with the blood. <u>It is the Spirit who testifies</u>, because the Spirit is truth. <u>For there are three that testify</u>: the <u>Spirit</u> and the <u>water</u> and the <u>blood</u>; and <u>the three are in agreement</u>... for the testimony of God is this, that <u>He has testified concerning His Son</u>... and the testimony is this, <u>that God has given us eternal life</u>, and this life is in <u>His Son</u>. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the <u>Son of God</u> does not have the life."

#### Significance... By **Grace** through **Faith**

"For <u>by grace</u> you have been saved <u>through faith</u>; and that <u>not of yourselves</u>, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast."

Grace - charis - unmerited favour.

Faith - pistis - conviction of the truth.

"not of yourselves"

We had NOTHING to do with our Salvation.

"by grace"

GOD <u>ALONE</u> is responsible for our Salvation.

"through faith"

Faith in GOD <u>ALONE</u> will result in Salvation.

#### A. Significance...

"And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God."

2 Corinthians 4:3-4

(John 16:11, Romans 1:18-20)

#### We could not <u>SEE</u> our <u>CONDEMNATION</u>.

"I have come as <u>Light</u> into the world, so that everyone who believes in Me will not remain in darkness."

John 12:46

#### CHRIST <u>REVEALED</u> to us our <u>CONDEMNATION</u>.

#### B. Significance...

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

Romans 3:23

"For the wages of sin is death but the free Gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Romans 6:23

#### We could not **ESCAPE** our **CONDEMNATION**.

"For <u>Christ</u> also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, so that <u>He</u> might bring us to God..."

1 Peter 3:18

(John 3:16 & Titus 2:11-14)

# CHRIST made <u>SALVATION</u> from our condemnation <u>POSSIBLE</u>.

#### C. Significance...

"There is <u>no</u> one righteous, <u>not</u> even one; there is <u>no</u> one who understands, <u>no</u> one seeks God."

\*\*Romans 3:10-20

"This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, <u>but men loved darkness instead of light</u> because their deeds were evil."

John 3:19

#### We did not <u>SEEK</u> GOD nor did we <u>DESIRE</u> CHRIST.

"No one can come to Me <u>unless</u> the Father who sent Me <u>draws</u> him and I will raise him up at the last day."

John 6:44, 6:65

#### Draws – helko – to drag or to impel.

"I now rejoice, not that you were <u>made sorrowful</u>, but that you were <u>made sorrowful</u> to the point of <u>repentance</u>; for you were <u>made sorrowful according to the will of God</u>, so that you might not suffer loss in anything through us. For the sorrow that is <u>according to the will of God produces a repentance</u> without regret, <u>leading to salvation</u>, but the sorrow of the world produces death."

2 Corinthians 7:9-10

(John 15:16)

# GOD <u>MADE</u> Christians <u>COME</u> to CHRIST and <u>REPENT</u> from their <u>SINS</u>.

#### D. Significance...

"But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised."

1 Corinthians 2:14

(1 Corinthians 1:18-21 & Romans 3:11)

#### We did not have the <u>MIND</u> to understand GOD.

"And we know that the Son of God has come, and has given us understanding so that we may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life."

1 John 5:20

(1 Corinthians 1:18, 23-24, Luke 24:45)

### GOD <u>GAVE</u> Christians the <u>UNDERSTANDING/COMPREHENSION</u> to understand CHRIST.

#### E. Significance...

"Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says, 'Jesus is accursed' and no one can say, 'Jesus is Lord,' except by the Holy Spirit."

1 Corinthians 12:3

(Hebrew 11:1, James 1:6)

#### We did not have the <u>FAITH</u> to <u>BELIEVE</u> in JESUS CHRIST.

"For to you it has been granted for Christ's sake, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake"

Philippians 1:29

# GOD <u>GAVE</u> Christians the <u>FAITH</u> to believe in JESUS CHRIST.

#### Saved by Grace through Faith

"not of yourselves"

- We could not <u>SEE</u> our <u>CONDEMNATION</u>.
- + CHRIST REVEALED to us our CONDEMNATION!
- We could not <u>ESCAPE</u> our <u>CONDEMNATION</u>.
  - + CHRIST made <u>SALVATION</u> from our condemnation <u>POSSIBLE!</u>
- We did not SEEK GOD nor did we WANT CHRIST.
  - + GOD <u>MADE</u> Christians come to CHRIST and <u>REPENT</u> from their sins!
- We did not have the <u>MIND</u> to understand GOD.
   + GOD <u>GAVE</u> Christians the <u>COMPREHENSION</u> to understand CHRIST!
- We did not have the FAITH to BELIEVE in CHRIST.
- + GOD GAVE Christians the FAITH to believe in CHRIST!

#### Saved by Grace through Faith

"For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; nor as a result of works, so that no one may boast."

Ephesians 2:8-9

The <u>ASSURANCE</u> of our <u>SALVATION</u> comes from the <u>TRUTH</u> that it is the <u>GIFT</u> of GOD and that we had <u>NOTHING</u> to do with it.

Since there is <u>NOTHING</u>
we can do to <u>EARN</u> it or <u>DESERVE</u> it,
then there is <u>NOTHING</u> we can do to <u>LOSE</u> it.
